



Rosh Hashanah 5778

(September 21, 2017; starts at sunset on September 20)

Passover

Mark 14:12 (NKJV) – ¹² Now on the first day of Unleavened Bread, when they killed the Passover *lamb*, His disciples said to Him, “Where do You want us to go and prepare, that You may eat the Passover?”

Mark 14:17-18 (NKJV) – ¹⁷ In the evening He came with the twelve. ¹⁸ Now as they sat and ate, Jesus said, “Assuredly, I say to you, one of you who eats with Me will betray Me.”

Firstfruits

Leviticus 23:5, 10-11 (NKJV) – ⁵ On the fourteenth *day* of the first month at twilight *is* the LORD’s Passover..... ¹⁰ “Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: ‘When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest. ¹¹ He shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted on your behalf; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.

Pentecost / Shavuot (Shavuah = Week / Shavuot = Weeks)

Leviticus 23:15-16 (NKJV) – ¹⁵ And you shall count for yourselves from the day after the Sabbath, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering: seven Sabbaths shall be completed. ¹⁶ Count fifty days to the day after the seventh Sabbath; then you shall offer a new grain offering to the LORD.

Acts 2:1 (NKJV) – When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

Leviticus 23 – the Feasts (mo'ed) of the LORD

- Sabbath (Lev. 23:3-4)

Matthew 24:36 (NKJV) – “But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only.”

Matthew 24:36 – Περὶ δὲ τῆς ἡμέρας ἐκείνης καὶ ὥρας οὐδεὶς οἶδεν, οὐδὲ οἱ ἄγγελοι τῶν οὐρανῶν οὐδὲ ὁ υἱός, εἰ μὴ ὁ πατήρ μόνος.

Περὶ - Peri – This is the root of the word perimeter.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 (TLV) – ¹³Now we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about those who are asleep, so that you may not grieve like the rest who have no hope. ¹⁴For if we believe that *Yeshua* died and rose again, so with Him God will also bring those who have fallen asleep in *Yeshua*. ¹⁵For this we tell you, by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord shall in no way precede those who are asleep.

¹⁶For the Lord Himself shall come down from heaven with a commanding shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the blast of God's shofar, and the dead in Messiah shall rise first.

¹⁷Then we who are alive, who are left behind, will be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air—and so we shall always be with the Lord. ¹⁸Therefore encourage one another with these words.

Revelation 4:1 (NKJV) – After these things I looked, and behold, a door *standing* open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, “Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place after this.”

Leviticus 23:23-25 (NIV) – ²³The LORD said to Moses, ²⁴“Say to the Israelites: ‘On the first day of the seventh month you are to have a day of rest, a sacred assembly commemorated with trumpet blasts. ²⁵Do no regular work, but present an offering made to the LORD by fire.’”

A day of: rest, sacred assembly, trumpets, offerings.
