Deuteronomy 33:13-16

¹³ And of Joseph he said:

“Blessed of the L-RD is his land,

Service Portion

1.) Irrigation

Psalm 126: 5,6 (NIV)

Those who sow with tears will reap with songs of joy. Those who go out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying sheaves with them.
