Deuteronomy 27:26

26 'Cursed is the one who does not confirm all the words of this law by observing them.' "And all the people shall say, 'Amen!"

James 2:10-11

10 For whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all. 11 For He who said, "Do not commit adultery," also said, "Do not murder." Now if you do not commit adultery, but you do murder, you have become a transgressor of the law.

1) It is written

Matthew 4:4 - 11

- 4 But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of G-d."
- 5 Then the devil took Him up into the holy city, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple.
- 6 and said to Him, "If You are the Son of G-d, throw Yourself down. For it is written: 'He shall give His angels charge over you,' and, 'In their hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone."
- 7 Yeshua said to him, "It is written again, 'You shall not tempt the L-rd your G-d."
- 8 Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory.
- 9 And he said to Him, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me."

10 Then Yeshua said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the L-rd your G-d, and Him only you shall serve."

Matthew 5:21, 22, 27, 28, 38, 39 40, 43, 44

- 21 "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder, and whoever murders will be in danger of the judgment.'
- 22 But I say to you that whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment. And whoever says to his brother, 'Raca!' shall be in danger of the council. But whoever says, 'You fool!' shall be in danger of hell fire.
- 27 "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not commit adultery.'
- 28 But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.
- 38 "You have heard that it was said, 'An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth.'

3) But I say Hebrews 3:1 – 5

1 Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Yeshua the Messiah,

- 2 who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house.
- 3 For this One has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house.
- 4 For every house is built by someone, but He who built all things is G-d.
- 5 And Moses indeed was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward

Romans 8:2 – 4

- 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Yeshua the Messiah has made me free from the law of sin and death.
