**Matthew 27:11**

Now Yeshua stood before the governor. And the governor asked him, saying, “Are You the King of the Jews?”  
Yeshua said to him, “*It is as you say.*”

**Isaiah 9:6**

#### **Isaiah 65:17**

### **Mark 5:1**

who had *his* dwelling among the tombs; and no one could bind him, not even with chains,

Also he begged Him earnestly that He would not send them out of the country.

**Mark 5:11**

Now a large herd of swine was feeding there near the mountains.

**Mark 5:12**

So all the demons begged Him, saying, “Send us to the swine, that we may enter them.”

**Mark 5:13**

And at once Yeshua gave them permission. Then the unclean spirits went out and entered the swine (there were about two thousand); and the herd ran violently down the steep place into the sea, and drowned in the sea.
