TORAH

Deuteronomy 11:10

For the land which you go to possess is not like the land of Egypt from which you have come, where you sowed your seed and watered it by foot, as a vegetable garden;

Deuteronomy 11:11

but the land which you cross over to possess is a land of hills and valleys, which drinks water from the rain of heaven,

Deuteronomy 11:12

a land for which the L-RD your G-d cares; the eyes of the L-RD your G-d are always on it, from the beginning of the year to the very end of the year.

SERVICE

1. Messiah has come

1 Corinthians 15:1

Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand,

1 Corinthians 15:2

by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain.

1 Corinthians 15:3

For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that the Messiah died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

1 Corinthians 15:4

and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,

1 Corinthians 15:5

and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve.

1 Corinthians 15:6

After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep.

1 Corinthians 15:7

After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles.

1 Corinthians 15:8

Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.

2. Messiah will come again

Acts 1:9

Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight.

Acts 1:10

And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel,

Acts 1:11

who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This *same* Yeshua, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."

Acts 1:12

Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is near Jerusalem, a Sabbath day's journey.

Zachariah 14:3

Then the L-RD will go forth
And fight against those nations,
As He fights in the day of battle.

Zachariah 14:4

And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives,
Which faces Jerusalem on the east.
And the Mount of Olives shall be split in two,
From east to west,
Making a very large valley;
Half of the mountain shall move toward the north
And half of it toward the south.

Zachariah 14:5

Then you shall flee *through* My mountain valley,
For the mountain valley shall reach to Azal.
Yes, you shall flee
As you fled from the earthquake

In the days of Uzziah king of Judah.

Thus the L-RD my G-d will come,
And all the saints with You.

Zachariah 14:6

It shall come to pass in that day
That there will be no light;
The lights will diminish.

Zachariah 14:7

It shall be one day
Which is known to the L-RD—
Neither day nor night.
But at evening time it shall happen
That it will be light.

Zachariah 14:8

And in that day it shall be
That living waters shall flow from Jerusalem,
Half of them toward the eastern sea
And half of them toward the western sea;
In both summer and winter it shall occur.

Zachariah 14:9

And the L-RD shall be King over all the earth.
In that day it shall be—

“ The L-RD *is* one,”
And His name one.

3. Messiah will sit upon His throne

Zachariah 14:10

All the land shall be turned into a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem. *Jerusalem*^[a] shall be raised up and inhabited in her place from Benjamin's Gate to the place of the First Gate and the Corner Gate, and *from* the Tower of Hananel to the king's winepresses.

Zachariah 14:11

The people shall dwell in it;
And no longer shall there be utter destruction,
But Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited.

Zachariah 14:12

And this shall be the plague with which the L-RD will strike all the people who fought against Jerusalem:

Their flesh shall dissolve while they stand on their feet,

Their eyes shall dissolve in their sockets,
And their tongues shall dissolve in their mouths.

Zachariah 14:13

It shall come to pass in that day
That a great panic from the L-RD will be among them.
Everyone will seize the hand of his neighbor,
And raise his hand against his neighbor's hand;

Zachariah 14:14

Judah also will fight at Jerusalem.
And the wealth of all the surrounding nations
Shall be gathered together:
Gold, silver, and apparel in great abundance.

Zachariah 14:15

Such also shall be the plague
On the horse *and* the mule,
On the camel and the donkey,
And on all the cattle that will be in those camps.
So *shall* this plague *be*.

Zachariah 14:16

And it shall come to pass *that* everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the L-RD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.

Zachariah 14:17

And it shall be *that* whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the L-RD of hosts, on them there will be no rain.

Zachariah 14:18

If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they *shall have no rain*; they shall receive the plague with which the L-RD strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.

Zachariah 14:19

This shall be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.

Zachariah 14:20

In that day "HOLINESS TO THE L-RD" shall be *engraved* on the bells of the horses. The pots in the L-RD's house shall be like the bowls before the altar.

Zachariah 14:21

Yes, every pot in Jerusalem and Judah shall be holiness to the L-RD of hosts. Everyone who sacrifices shall come and take them and cook in them. In that day there shall no longer be a Canaanite in the house of the L-RD of hosts.

4. Are you ready?
