Review Key Scriptures: Genesis 2:20–25

1. Demystifying Marriage

When God created marriage, He intended that it would be an intimate haven of lifelong love, passion, and oneness for a man and a woman. To ensure every couple would succeed, He spoke four laws of love into existence at the moment the first marriage came into existence. Covenant marriages promote security and well-being and are focused on the benefit of the other person.

2. The Four Laws of Love

The purpose of laws is to bring order, safety, and predictability. A world without laws would be chaos. The four laws of love create order, trust, and predictability in a marriage. They create, promote, and protect love in a marriage. When God's laws of love are honored, marriage is the safest relationship on earth.

3. The Law of Priority

God expects men to lead, and leadership is one of a woman's most important needs in marriage. Wives want their husbands to be the loving initiator of the well-being of home and marriage while treating them as equals. Both spouses must reprioritize their lives to make the marriage first place. Marriage only works

in first place. If it is second to anyone or anything else, it won't work. Allow your spouse to be honest, train your children to respect your marriage, and make time for each other.

- 6. What are some ways you can reprioritize your relationship with your spouse above any other relationship or life pursuit?
- 7. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you?
