Focus Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6).

Review Key Scriptures: John 14:6, 3:16, 11:35, 19:41–44; Acts 4:12; Psalm 119:68, 86:5, 98:2, 7:11; Luke 19:10; 1 Samuel 2:27; Jeremiah 29:11–13; Deuteronomy 4:29; Proverbs 8:17

1. God is good.

Psalm 86:5 tells us that the Lord is good and ready to forgive all who call upon Him. In the Garden of Eden, Adam and Eve hid from God when they sinned. God sought them because He is good, and He loves abundantly. Jesus, the Son of Man, came to seek and to save that which is lost. God reveals Himself to everyone.

2. God is just.

God would not be just if He didn't give everyone a chance to find Him. You choose where you will spend eternity. No one can say: God rejected me. But God can say: you rejected Me. He gives each of us a choice, and He will not violate your choice.

3. God is love.

God is inclusive. *Whoever* chooses to believe is welcome into His family. Our goodness and love cannot compare to God's. God's love for us is deeper than we can imagine. Jesus only wept twice: first when Lazarus died because He was moved by Mary and Martha's great loss of their brother, and second over Jerusalem and its great loss at not recognizing the day of His visitation.

Discuss

1. Have you ever felt excluded from a group? How did that make you feel?
2. Does Jesus exclude anyone from His family? Refer to John 3:16.
3. How has God shown you His goodness?
4. How has God shown you His justice?
5. How has God shown you His love?

Take Home As we conclude, remember the following:

- If you seek Him with all your heart, you will find Him.
- God wants to be found by you. He will reveal Himself to you.
- God is good, just, and love.
