• God's dream

In Mark 14, Jesus visits the home of Simon the leper. Leprosy was a horrible, incurable disease, and no one wanted to be around lepers, but that didn't stop Jesus. Simon was a part of God's dream. God values every single person. He doesn't see us in our sin, sickness, or failure. He sees us beyond our issues. God loves people and sees them through the eyes of a loving Father.

Our dreams

Mary had a dream. Her dream was to get married and have a family. That is why she planned and saved the perfume; it was her dowry. So when she poured the perfume over Jesus's feet, she was pouring out her dream on Jesus. Mary gave up her dream so that God could have His dream, and that is the spirit of the gospel. The gospel can only be successfully promoted by believers who value God's dream over their own and who are willing to sacrifice their dream for His.

Laying down our dreams

We must surrender our personal dreams to God. Greed and selfishness blind us to the gospel and the importance of God's dream. The greatest threat to God's dream of building a family through the preaching of the gospel is our unsurrendered dream. Selfishness causes us to pursue

Tip Of The Week

Facilitating Small Groups
Be comfortable with silence.

- Wait 4–5 seconds after asking a question.
- Make eye contact with various people.
- Rephrase (do not change) the question, and wait again.

It takes 5–8 seconds for people to hear a question, comprehend the meaning, and formulate a response. Give it time. If no one answers after the second time around, your question is unclear, too complicated, or irrelevant to your group. Move on to a new question.
