Key Scriptures: 2 Corinthians 5:20; 2 Peter 1:3; Psalm 1:1

Discuss

1. How would you describe excellence?
2. Do you know someone who walks in excellence? What are the characteristics that set them apart?
3. What does it mean to have childlike obedience, and why is this important regarding excellence?
4. Joyce Meyer talked about listening to the still, small voice of the Holy Spirit in little areas. How can we cultivate a sensitivity to obeying God's voice?
5. How does choosing excellence affect what we do when no one is watching?
6. How can you model characteristics of excellence in your life, and in which areas would you like to build those traits in this season?
7. Take a moment to pray and let God speak to each person about any areas of mediocrity He is asking them to change. Commit these areas to the Lord.
8. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you through this message?

Takeaway

As we conclude, remember the following:

- Be a person of excellence.
- Keep your word.
- Manage money with integrity.

Leader Tip

As you look for ways to grow, ask God for wisdom in your leadership. He is with you!

Group Dynamics Idea

Easter week is a great time to reach out to neighbors, people in need, and the community. As a group, brainstorm how you can make a difference. Pray and ask God to give you creative ideas. It could be as simple as asking people to join your group, or it could be an outreach your group does for the community. Whatever it is, be proactive about reaching out during this time, and plan to invite at least one person to an Easter service.
