## **Discuss**

- 1. What do you think Pastor Robert meant when he said we have spiritual eyes?
- 2. Read John 9:35–41. What do you think it means to be spiritually blind?
- 3. Pastor Robert shared Jesus wants to heal us spiritually and mentally. What does this mean to you?
- 4. Why is humility necessary to receive healing from Jesus?
- 5. Do you believe Jesus still wants to heal us today? Why or why not?
- 6. Read Matthew 8:17. If Jesus bore our sicknesses, why do we still get sick?
- 7. Have you experienced a time when Jesus opened your spiritual eyes? What happened?
- 8. Have you invited Jesus to heal you in every area of your life? If not, take time now to ask Him to heal you.
- 9. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you through this message?

As we conclude, remember the following:

- Jesus heals us spiritually and physically.
- Jesus came to give recovery of sight to the blind.
- Jesus wants to open our spiritual eyes.
