Key Scriptures: Luke 8:40-56

Discuss

- 1. Pastor Tim said society is okay with acknowledging Jesus but they keep Him at a distance. Do you think this is true? Why or why not?
- 2. Why do many of us come to Jesus as a last resort?
- 3. In Luke 8:48, Jesus told the woman with the issue of blood that her faith had made her well. How did the woman's faith activate her healing?
- 4. Pastor Tim shared there is a difference between pressing against God's presence and touching God's presence. What is the difference to you?
- 5. How can we deliberately connect with Jesus in our everyday lives?
- 6. Jesus told the woman that her faith had made her well and she could go in peace. Can you think of a time God said this to you? Share if you are comfortable.
- 7. What would you reach out to touch Jesus for today?
- 8. Pastor Tim said, "Jesus can do that, too." What does this phrase mean to you?
- 9. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you through this message?

Takeaway

As we conclude, remember the following:

- Jesus wants us to reach out to Him with faith.
- Jesus wants to heal us in every way.

Leader Tip

Group Dynamics Idea
