Focus

Open

In one or two sentences, describe what you hope will be your biggest lifetime contribution to society? Why?

Talk

- 1. Read Luke 4:18. Jesus describes several different facets of His ministry.
 - Do you believe that every ministry He lists applies to every individual? Why or why not?
 - Which of the ministries listed do you feel is most needed in your life right now (salvation, healing, freedom, etc.), and why?
- 2. As Jesus' ambassadors, we are anointed to carry out His ministry on earth. Which facets of ministry listed in Luke 4:18 (or other facets) do you feel most passionate about and/or called to? Why?
- 3. Read Ephesians 4:16. On a scale of 1 to 5, how important do you believe it is for you *personally* to serve others (1 = not very important; 5 = critically important)? Does your typical routine currently reflect this?
- 4. In groups of two or three, reflect on this statement: "Vision is a mental picture of what could be, fueled by the conviction that it should be."
 - Based on the facet of ministry you chose in Question 2, what are some practical ways you could serve others more often or effectively in this area of ministry in Gateway Church? Outside the church?

Live

In your groups of two or three, decide on one step you will take this month to serve others. Take a moment to pray for each other.
