Over the next six weeks, we're going to do something simple but powerful: **we're going to sit with questions Jesus asked.**

Jesus didn't ask questions because He needed information; He asked questions because ***we need transformation***. His questions have a way of uncovering what's really going on in our hearts and minds and revealing who He truly is.

This 42-day Scripture study will take you on a journey through the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus, because **His questions weren't just for people back then—they're for us today.**

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Your Bible
- A Journal & Pen
- Optional: Worship Music (Try streaming Gateway Worship's *Chapel Sessions* for peaceful worship or *Gateway Atmosphere - Vol. 1* for something instrumental.)

EACH DAY INCLUDES:

- A Scripture Passage (your reading for the day)
- A Question Jesus Asked
- A Character Attribute of Jesus Revealed Through the Story
- Short Prompts to Guide Your Scripture Study

You don't need a perfect routine, just a consistent one.

A DAILY PLAN:

1. Read the Passage (5–10 Minutes)
2. Write the Key Verse (2–4 Minutes)
3. SOAP Prompts + Prayer (5–10 Minutes)

If you miss a day, don't quit! You're not striving for perfection, you're building habits. Just pick up where you left off.

THE SOAP METHOD (SIMPLE & POWERFUL)

SOAP is a simple way to slow down, listen closely, and let Scripture shape you.

S – Scripture

Read the passage slowly (even twice). Then write the key verse word-for-word in your journal or this guide.

Don't rush this. Writing Scripture helps you notice details you might otherwise miss.

O – Observation

Ask questions like:

- What stands out?
- What repeated words or themes do I see?
- What does this reveal about Jesus?
- What does this reveal about people (and me)?

Write a few sentences in your own words.

A – Application

This is where Scripture becomes personal:

- What is Jesus inviting me to believe?
- What action do I need to take?
- What needs to change in me?
- What step of obedience is God highlighting?

Keep it specific. One clear next step is better than ten vague ideas.

P – Prayer

Pray honestly in response:

- Thank God for what you see.
- Confess what's being exposed.
- Ask for help to live out the steps He's highlighted.
- Pray the Scripture back to God.

Be honest and specific in your prayers. And remember, this isn't about having all the "right words;" it's about connecting with the Father and inviting Him into your day.

SOAP METHOD SUMMARY

S – Scripture: Read the passage slowly (once or twice). Write out the key verse word-for-word each day.

O – Observation: What stands out? What does this reveal about Jesus?

A – Application: What is Jesus inviting/challenging me to do today?

P – Prayer: Pray in response—be honest, personal, and specific.

There are prompt questions and example prayers for each day—use them as a guide or create your own to accompany the daily Scripture reading.

THE GOAL

The goal of this guide is not information—it's transformation. As you navigate these questions, we believe you'll discover:

- Jesus is closer than you think.
- His questions are kinder than we expect.
- And His voice is still calling us forward today.

Let's begin!

WEEK 1

DAY 1 | SUNDAY, MARCH 1

Passage: Matthew 16:13–28 (Peter Declares Jesus Is the Messiah)

Question: “Who do you say I am?” (v. 15)

Attribute: Jesus Is a Revealer

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Matthew 16:15).

O What does Jesus’ question reveal about what others believe versus what I believe?

A Where have I been living on secondhand faith?

P Jesus, reveal Yourself to me again so my faith is rooted in personal revelation, not secondhand belief. Open my heart to know You more deeply and to boldly confess who You are with trust and obedience. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 2 | MONDAY, MARCH 2

Passage: John 1:35–51 (Jesus Calls His Disciples)

Question: “What do you want?” (v. 38)

Attribute: Jesus Is an Inviter

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (John 1:38).

O What are these disciples truly seeking?

A What am I actually looking for from Jesus right now?

P Jesus, You invite me to follow You. Make my desires pure, so I can seek You for who You are, not just for what You can give. Settle my heart with Your will and teach me to want what truly leads to life in You. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 3 | TUESDAY, MARCH 3

Passage: Mark 4:35–41 (Jesus Calms the Storm)

Question: “Why are you so afraid?” (v. 40)

Attribute: Jesus Is a Peace-Giver

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Mark 4:40).

O What does fear reveal about faith?

A What “storm” am I in and what lie am I believing?

P Jesus, reveal Yourself to me again so my faith is rooted in personal revelation, not secondhand belief. Open my heart to know You more deeply and to boldly confess who You are with trust and obedience. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 4 | WEDNESDAY, MARCH 4

Passage: Luke 5:17–26 (Jesus Forgives & Heals a Paralyzed Man)

Question: “Why are you thinking these things in your hearts?” (v. 22)

Attribute: Jesus Is All-Knowing

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Luke 5:22).

O What does Jesus perceive that others miss?

A Where do I need to surrender my private thoughts to God?

P Jesus, You see and know every thought in my heart. Search me and gently reveal what I need to surrender to You. Heal what is hidden within me and replace it with truth, freedom, and wholeness. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 5 | THURSDAY, MARCH 5

Passage: Mark 2:1–12 (Jesus Forgives & Heals a Paralyzed Man)

Question: “Which is easier: to say ... ‘Your sins are forgiven,’ or to say, ‘Get up, take your mat and walk?’” (v. 9)

Attribute: Jesus Has Authority

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Mark 2:10).

O What authority does Jesus claim here?

A What do I need—healing, forgiveness ... or both?

P Jesus, You have authority to forgive my sins and heal every broken place in my life. I confess my need for You today. Forgive me. Heal me. Reveal Your love for me so I can trust Your power at work in me. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 6 | FRIDAY, MARCH 6

Passage: John 5:1–15 (Jesus Heals at the Pool of Bethesda)

Question: “Do you want to get well?” (v. 6)

Attribute: Jesus Is a Restorer

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (John 5:6).

O Why might someone not want healing?

A What brokenness have I normalized?

P Jesus, You are my Restorer. Please give me the courage to want the healing You offer. Help me leave behind old patterns I’ve normalized and step fully into the wholeness You are calling me toward. In Your name, Amen.

WEEK 2

DAY 8 | SUNDAY, MARCH 8

Passage: Luke 15:1–7 (The Parable of the Lost Sheep)

Question: “Doesn’t he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it?” (v. 4)

Attribute: Jesus Is a Seeker

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Luke 15:4).

O What does Jesus’ question reveal about God’s heart?

A Where have I wandered—or where am I hiding?

P Jesus, You are the Seeker. If I’ve wandered or hidden in any area of my life, come find me again and gently bring me back to You. Help me rest in the truth of Your pursuing love and respond with a heart fully surrendered to Yours. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 9 | MONDAY, MARCH 9

Passage: Luke 10:25–37 (The Parable of the Good Samaritan)

Question: “What is written in the Law? ... How do you read it?” (v. 26)

Attribute: Jesus Is a Teacher

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Luke 10:26).

O What kind of question is Jesus answering with His own questions?

A Who is my neighbor this week?

P Jesus, You are my Teacher. Shape the way I read, understand, and live out Your Word with truth and humility. Give me a selfless compassion and open my eyes to love my neighbor the way You love me. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 10 | TUESDAY, MARCH 10

Passage: Mark 3:20–35 (A New Family)

Question: “Who are my mother and my brothers?” (v. 33)

Attribute: Jesus Welcomes Us

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Mark 3:35).

O What does Jesus say makes someone part of His family?

A Who do I need to welcome the way Jesus welcomed me?

P Jesus, thank You for welcoming me into Your family. Teach me to extend that same welcome to others and build unity and love within Your spiritual family. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 11 | WEDNESDAY, MARCH 11

Passage: John 6:60–69 (Many Disciples Desert Jesus)

Question: “You do not want to leave too, do you?” (v. 67)

Attribute: Jesus Is a Refiner

S Write out the key verses from today’s Scripture passage (John 6:67–68).

O What makes faith difficult here?

A Where do I drift when discipleship is costly?

P Jesus, You are my Refiner. Please help me stand firm when it’s difficult and the cost is high. I want to stay in Your Presence; hold me close, strengthen my faith, and keep my heart fully devoted to You. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 12 | THURSDAY, MARCH 12

Passage: Mark 7:1–23 (Clean Hands, Clean Heart)

Question: “Don’t you see that nothing that enters a person from the outside can defile them?” (v. 18)

Attribute: Jesus Is a Purifier

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Mark 7:20).

O What does Jesus say truly defiles a person?

A What heart posture needs cleansing in me?

P Jesus, You are my Purifier. Will You cleanse my heart—not just my outward actions? Reveal the areas in me that need Your cleansing touch. Help me live with a heart purely devoted to You. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 13 | FRIDAY, MARCH 13

Passage: Mark 10:46–52 (Blind Bartimaeus Receives His Sight)

Question: “What do you want me to do for you?” (v. 51)

Attribute: Jesus Is Compassionate

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Mark 10:51).

O Why does Jesus make him say it out loud?

A What do I need to ask Jesus plainly?

P Jesus, You are compassionate. Help me to ask boldly and honestly for what I truly need from You. Open my eyes and heart to receive Your healing and mercy today. In Your name, Amen.

WEEK 3

DAY 15 | SUNDAY, MARCH 15

Passage: Mark 10:17-31 (The Rich Young Ruler)

Question: "Why do you call me good?" (v. 18)

Attribute: Jesus Is Holy

S Write out the key verse from today's Scripture passage (Mark 10:18).

O What does Jesus expose about goodness and worship?

A What is hardest for me to release?

P Jesus, You are holy. Please help me release anything I've placed above You. You are my greatest treasure, and I worship You! Reorder my heart so that all I seek flows from You alone. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 16 | MONDAY, MARCH 16

Passage: Mark 8:27-38 (Take Up Your Cross)

Question: "What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul?" (v. 36)

Attribute: Jesus Sees What Matters Most

S Write out the key verse from today's Scripture passage (Mark 8:36).

O What does Jesus value most?

A Where am I trading eternity for temporary comfort?

P Jesus, help me see what truly matters. No temporary comfort is better than being in Your Presence. Give me the courage to take up my cross and follow You, trusting that losing my life for Your sake brings eternal gain. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 17 | TUESDAY, MARCH 17

Passage: Matthew 6:25–34 (Do Not Worry)

Question: “why do you worry ...?” (v. 28)

Attribute: Jesus Is Our Provider

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Matthew 6:33).

O What does worry reveal about trust?

A What do I need to seek first today?

P Jesus, You are my Provider, so help me surrender my worries and trust You with my every need. Teach me to seek Your kingdom first and rest in the assurance You provide. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 18 | WEDNESDAY, MARCH 18

Passage: John 3:1–21 (Jesus Talks with Nicodemus)

Question: “You are Israel’s teacher ... and do you not understand these things?” (v. 10)

Attribute: Jesus Gives New Life

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (John 3:3).

O What does Jesus say Nicodemus is missing?

A Where have I been trying to change from the outside-in instead of letting Jesus first change my heart?

P Jesus, You give new life and change me from the inside out so my heart truly reflects You. I don’t want religion; I want the transformation only You can bring. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 19 | THURSDAY, MARCH 19

Passage: Luke 6:43–49 (Good Fruit & Good Foundations)

Question: “Why do you call me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and do not do what I say?” (v. 46)

Attribute: Jesus Is Lord

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Luke 6:46).

O What’s the difference between admiration and obedience?

A Where do I need to obey quickly?

P Jesus, You are Lord. Please help me move from mere admiration to whole-hearted obedience in every area of my life. Lead me to build my life on Your truth so I produce good fruit that lasts. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 20 | FRIDAY, MARCH 20

Passage: Matthew 20:20–28 (Greatness Reframed)

Question: “Can you drink the cup ...?” (v. 22)

Attribute: Jesus Leads Differently

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Matthew 20:26).

O How is Jesus’ definition of greatness different from the world’s?

A Where am I chasing status instead of serving?

P Jesus, You lead differently. You reshape my ambition to serve rather than to gain status. Reveal Your love for me so I can humbly follow Your example of selfless love. In Your name, Amen.

WEEK 4

DAY 22 | SUNDAY, MARCH 22

Passage: Mark 5:21–43 (Jesus Raises a Dead Girl & Heals a Sick Woman)

Question: “Who touched my clothes?” (v. 30)

Attribute: Jesus Is Personal

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Mark 5:34).

O What does Jesus stop for?

A Where do I need to move from anonymous faith to personal trust?

P Jesus, You meet me personally. You see my needs—the ones I share with others and the ones I keep to myself. I want to move from a distant faith to a trust with my whole heart. Show me that You notice even my smallest acts of faith and respond with Your healing and love for me. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 23 | MONDAY, MARCH 23

Passage: Matthew 8:5–13

Question: “Shall I come and heal him?” (v. 7)

Attribute: Jesus Meets Us Where We Are

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Matthew 8:10).

O What about the centurion’s request amazes Jesus?

A What area of my life do I need to bring full of faith to Jesus?

P Jesus, You are my Restorer, Redeemer, and Healer. Help me approach You with boldness and faith, believing You can meet me right where I am. And when I struggle to believe, help me with my unbelief. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 24 | TUESDAY, MARCH 24

Passage: Matthew 20:29–34 (Two Blind Men Receive Sight)

Question: “What do you want me to do for you?” (v. 32)

Attribute: Jesus Is Merciful

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Matthew 20:32).

O What kind of mercy do they ask for?

A What do I need Jesus to open my eyes to?

P Jesus, You are merciful, opening my eyes to see both the spiritual and practical needs in my life. Give me the courage to ask boldly and trust You to bring me healing and understanding. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 25 | WEDNESDAY, MARCH 25

Passage: John 8:1–11 (The Woman Caught in Adultery)

Question: “Has no one condemned you?” (v. 10)

Attribute: Jesus Is Our Defender

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (John 8:11).

O How does Jesus treat the accused versus the accusers?

A Where do I need to receive grace and walk away from sin?

P Jesus, You are my Defender. Thank You for showing me mercy when I don’t deserve it. Help me receive Your grace, confess my sins, and walk in the freedom and protection You offer daily. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 26 | THURSDAY, MARCH 26

Passage: John 9:1–41 (Jesus Heals a Man Born Blind)

Question: “Do you believe in the Son of Man?” (v. 35)

Attribute: Jesus Is the Light of the World

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (John 9:35).

O What does this healing reveal about faith and belief?

A What do I need to believe, even if it costs me socially?

P Jesus, You are the Light of the world. Help me believe in You fully, even when it costs me comfort or approval. Strengthen my faith and my witness so my life clearly reflects Your truth and light to others. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 27 | FRIDAY, MARCH 27

Passage: Matthew 10:1–42 (Jesus Sends Out the Twelve Disciples)

Question: “Are not two sparrows sold for a penny?” (v. 29)

Attribute: Jesus Cares for Us

S Write out the key verses from today’s Scripture passage (Matthew 10:29–31).

O What does Jesus say God sees that we think no one sees?

A What fear, worry, or anxiety do I need to release today because Jesus cares for me?

P Jesus, You care for me deeply and see every detail of my life. I want to trust Your loving attention more than my fear or anxiety. Today I release my worries to You and rest in the truth that I am known, valued, and held by Your care. In Your name, Amen.

WEEK 5

DAY 29 | SUNDAY, MARCH 29 (PALM SUNDAY)

Passage: John 13:1–17 (The King with a Towel)

Question: “Do you understand what I have done for you?” (v. 12)

Attribute: Jesus Is the Servant King

S Write out the key verses from today’s Scripture passage (John 13:14–15).

O What kind of power does Jesus use?

A Where can I serve in a way that costs me pride?

P Jesus, You are the Servant King. Please teach me to understand Your way of leading through humility and love. Give me a servant heart this week so I’m willing to lay down my pride and serve others as You have served me. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 30 | MONDAY, MARCH 30

Passage: Luke 22:39–46 (Jesus Prays on the Mount of Olives)

Question: “Why are you sleeping?” (v. 46)

Attribute: Jesus Is Prayerful

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Luke 22:46).

O What does Jesus pray under pressure?

A Where have I been spiritually asleep?

P Jesus, awaken my heart where I’ve grown spiritually asleep and teach me to pray instead of panic when pressure comes. Strengthen me to face trials with trust and obedience, choosing God’s will over my own. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 31 | TUESDAY, MARCH 31

Passage: Matthew 26:36–46 (Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane)

Question: “My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me.” (v. 39)

Attribute: Jesus Is Submitted

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Matthew 26:39).

O What does Jesus do when He’s overwhelmed?

A What would it look like for me to say, “Not my will, but Yours” today?

P Jesus, when I feel overwhelmed, teach me to follow Your example of surrender and trust the Father completely. Show me where I’ve been stubborn, and give me the strength to say, “Not my will, but Yours.” In Your name, Amen.

DAY 32 | WEDNESDAY, APRIL 1

Passage: Luke 22:47–62 (Jesus Is Betrayed & Denied by His Disciples)

Question: “are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?” (v. 48)

Attribute: Jesus Is Forgiving

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Luke 22:48).

O How does Jesus respond when those closest to Him hurt Him deeply?

A Where am I tempted to retaliate or hold onto bitterness instead of forgiving?

P Jesus, You are forgiving even when deeply betrayed. Heal the places in me that want to hold onto bitterness. Give me Your grace to really forgive, releasing this hurt into Your hands and trusting You with my heart. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 33 | THURSDAY, APRIL 2

Passage: John 18:1–9 (Jesus Is Arrested)

Question: “Who is it you want?” (v. 4)

Attribute: Jesus Is Unshaken

S Write out the key verses from today’s Scripture passage (John 18:8–9).

O What is Jesus’ posture in this moment? Is He fearful or fearless?

A Where do I need to stop panicking and trust that Jesus is still in control?

P Jesus, You are unshaken and in control. I want to stop panicking and trust Your steady presence when I feel overwhelmed. Remind me that nothing surprises You and I can rest in Your strength and sovereignty. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 34 | FRIDAY, APRIL 3

Passage: John 18:19–24 (Jesus Before the High Priest)

Question: “if I spoke the truth, why did you strike me?” (v. 23)

Attribute: Jesus Always Speaks Truth

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (John 18:23).

O What does Jesus do when He’s treated unfairly?

A Where am I tempted to twist the truth (to protect myself, avoid conflict, look better, etc.)?

P Jesus, You always speak truth. Please give me the courage to speak the truth, even when it costs me. Shape my heart and words to reflect Your honesty, grace, and integrity in every situation. In Your name, Amen.

WEEK 6

DAY 36 | SUNDAY, APRIL 5 (EASTER)

Passage: John 20:1–18 (The Empty Tomb & Jesus Appears to Mary Magdalene)

Question: “Why are you crying? Who is it you are looking for?” (v. 15)

Attribute: Jesus Is the Risen Lord

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (John 20:16).

O What changes when Jesus calls Mary by name?

A What am I looking for besides Jesus Himself?

P Jesus, thank You for calling me by name and reminding me that You are alive and victorious. Help me seek You above all else, worshiping You with my heart, my mind, and my life. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 37 | MONDAY, APRIL 6

Passage: Luke 24:13–35 (The Road to Emmaus)

Question: “What are you discussing together ...?” (v. 17)

Attribute: Jesus Opens Our Eyes

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Luke 24:32).

O What does Jesus do before revealing Himself?

A How can I listen to Scripture differently?

P Jesus, open my eyes and help me recognize You in Your Word and in every moment of my life. Please give me understanding and wisdom. Reveal Your love for me so I desire to follow Your ways even more. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 38 | TUESDAY, APRIL 7

Passage: Luke 24:36–49 (Jesus Appears to the Disciples)

Question: “Why are you troubled, and why do doubts rise in your minds?” (v. 38)

Attribute: Jesus Is a Peace-Giver

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Luke 24:38).

O What does Jesus offer first after resurrection?

A Where do I need peace today?

P Lord, calm the fears and doubts in my heart and fill me with Your peace that surpasses all understanding. Help me trust in Your presence and walk confidently in Your resurrection power! In Your name, Amen.

DAY 39 | WEDNESDAY, APRIL 8

Passage: John 21:1–14 (Jesus & the Miraculous Catch of Fish)

Question: “Friends, haven’t you any fish?” (v. 5)

Attribute: Jesus Meets Our Needs

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (John 21:6).

O What does this story reveal about the risen Jesus? Is He distant or involved?

A Where do I feel like I’m coming up empty right now and need Jesus to provide?

P Jesus, I bring You my empty nets and trust You to meet my needs with Your abundant provision. Help me to follow You and rely on You in every area of my life. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 40 | THURSDAY, APRIL 9

Passage: John 21:15–19 (Jesus Restores Peter)

Question: “Simon son of John, do you love me ...?” (v. 15)

Attribute: Jesus Never Gives Up on Us

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (John 21:17).

O How did Jesus respond to Peter after his failure?

A Where do I need to stop living in guilt or shame and return to Jesus with honesty today?

P Jesus, thank You for never giving up on me, even when I fail. Heal my heart with Your love for me. Restore my spirit and help me love You fully today. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 41 | FRIDAY, APRIL 10

Passage: John 21:19–22 (Jesus Instructs Peter)

Question: “what is that to you? You must follow me.” (v. 22)

Attribute: Jesus Calls Us to Follow Him

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (John 21:22).

O What does Jesus teach Peter about comparison and distraction?

A Where am I tempted to compare my life or calling to someone else’s instead of simply following Jesus?

P Jesus, help me to keep my eyes fixed on You and follow Your ways without distraction. Free me from comparison and guide me to walk faithfully, step by step, in Your calling for my life. In Your name, Amen.

DAY 42 | SATURDAY, APRIL 11 (FINALE)

Passage: Acts 9:1–22 (Saul Meets the Risen Jesus)

Question: “Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?” (v. 4)

Attribute: Jesus Is the Living Lord

S Write out the key verse from today’s Scripture passage (Acts 9:4).

O What does this reveal about Jesus’ authority right now?

A What needs to be confronted or changed in me?
